- To go directly to a specific chapter, click on the respective chapter in the Table of Contents in the document window.


The illustrations below also apply to the SOD.

### 1) Enter comments

The **SOD is numbered consecutively** throughout the document. **Line numbering starts anew with each page. The report can be commented on page by page and line by line.** Please do this directly in the field next to the document window and enter the corresponding digits for it. In this way, the comments can be clearly assigned to the respective chapters. **To refer to the entire document and/or the entire page with a comment, please enter "0"** when specifying page/line.

Your **entered comments will be saved**, you can see them above the document.



### 2) View and readability


Depending on your monitor and view settings, the readability and view of the document can be changed.
